Arrival

All students will enter the building through their grade level entrance - 6th grade walkers will enter the building through the auditorium doors. 6th grade busers will enter through the UA Hallway at the back of the building- staff will be outside and throughout the building to help guide students

Lockers

Supplies for Day 1




All students should bring a backpack with the following items:

Powerschool

This is where you will find your schedule and grades.



Parent Square

This is a tool that teachers and administrators will use to send out important information to your parents.

What's different about middle school?

- Middle school is a very important time because it sets the foundation for your success in high school!
- Unlike elementary school, you will be learning in 7 different classes with different teachers!
- You will be on a team. A team is where all of your academic classes are. There are 2 teams in 6th grade. Each team has five teachers. There are 7 periods in a day. You will have have 5 academic classes and 2 specials each day.



Middle School Classes



- First period begins at 7:55 am.
- School ends at 2:15pm except on Thursdays, it ends at 1:44pm.
- Teachers are available for help before, during, and after school except on Thursdays!




